“You have asked to have your child baptised. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him/her in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring your child up to keep God’s commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbour. You should therefore clearly understand what you are undertaking.”

When you have your child baptised in the Catholic Church you do so because you wish him/her to grow up as a practising Catholic, attending Mass on Sundays, and receiving the sacraments. As parents it will be your duty to bring your child regularly to Church even when he/she is still very young, so that your child can grow familiar with the practice of the Catholic religion. It will be your duty to see that he/she learns about the faith. You will have to teach him/her much of this yourself with the help of the Catholic School.

When you have your child baptised you make a promise before God that you will see to these things to the best of your ability. This is a serious thing to do and should not be done lightly.

Eventually you must answer to God for your response to this promise.
