REFLECTION

Reflection Thirteenth Sunday year B

Today’s Gospel helps us to see why Faith is important. Faith helps to heal and to give life. In the Gospel it does this in a physical way, but for us, on the whole, it will be in a spiritual way.

The woman who touches his clothes so that she might be healed, did something which many of us would like to do, which is to touch the Son of God. She has faith in his powers and has the belief that he is the Son of God. How often in life do we reach out hoping for a miracle. Of course, we have the power of prayer and the knowledge that God works in our world through the Holy Spirit. But we would love to have the opportunity the woman had to reach out and touch his cloak.

The little girl who is brought back to life, reminds us that through Jesus we have life. The first two readings today remind us that God gives life. We are told the girl is twelve years old. The number twelve helps us to think of the Tribes of Israel and the Apostles, both of whom gave life to the community of Israel and beyond.

Our faith helps us to live our lives to the full. Sometimes when we are going through tough times in life, it can be our faith that gets us through. There will be times when we think that we have lost faith. This is not true. God never leaves us. He may seem to be distant to us, but he is still there.
