Reflection for 5th Sunday of Lent Year A

In today’s Gospel, we hear about Jesus performing the ultimate miracle, the ultimate sign by raising Lazarus from the dead. By doing this he is showing us many things. Firstly, that he is really the Christ because only the Son of God would have the power to raise someone from the dead, also that each one of us has nothing to fear from death. There is a life to come, a life in a place which we refer to as heaven or paradise.

Many of us fear death because it is when we enter the unknown. We are not quite sure what heaven will be like or what we will see. We feel safe with the world which we can see and which we know, the unknown can scare us. Yet through the resurrection of Lazarus we know that the life to come will be something amazing.

I am always reminded of a particular lecture that I attended whilst I was in training and one of my fellow students put his hand up and asked; “Exactly what will I see when I go to heaven”? The lecturer leant back in his chair and said that the first thing to remember is that we will have our resurrected body, which will be our perfect self. We would probably be able to see Jesus and he would probably greet us. Then the student asked; “What about God? Will I see God”? The lecturer replied; “You may not see but you will understand”!

The resurrection of Lazarus is a miracle which we haven’t seen but we understand its importance. The same is true when we go to heaven, we may be scared but we know it will be paradise.
