**REFLECTION**

Reflection for the Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C

Today’s Gospel reminds me of a darts match that took part in many years ago. Whilst we were playing another chap who came to watch was giving us advice, about the technique of throwing darts and what numbers to aim at. I asked him why wasn’t he playing? He said that he was only use to playing at a much higher standard than us. After the match I asked for his advice about how to hit a certain score. He then proceeded to demonstration, but even though he had several attempts, he couldn’t do it. To indemnify this failure he blamed the darts, the board and the noise in the pub.

Jesus reminds us in the Gospel to keep our heart and souls in good health. He reminds us that it can be very easy to be hypocritical. There can be nothing worse than giving advice only to be caught out later on not applying to our own lives.
