REFLECTION

Feast of Corpus Christie year B

In our reading from Exodus today we are reminded of the promise made to Moses and sealed with the blood of an animal. The Ten Commandments are to be kept by the Israelites and God will look after them. The Gospel then reminds us of the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper.

One of the memories I had of running the London Marathon many years ago was having to get up early and trying to eat a chicken and pasta meal so that I would have the strength to complete the course. I then rubbed some oil into my joints and some ointment on my knee which was recovering from an injury. I did all this so that I would be ready for the race.

This feast we celebrate today reminds us of the promise that Jesus made with us at the Last supper. If we eat his Body, we are made strong and if we drink his blood we are washed clean. The Eucharist is food for our soul as we journey through life. Jesus feeds our heart with his body and washes our soul clean with his blood.
