REFLECTION

In today’s Gospel, we hear Jesus reprimand Peter because Peter does not want his master to suffer. But Jesus knows that he has to place himself into the hands of his Father if he is win salvation for all. He then tells His disciples that if they want to truly follow Him then they must take up their cross to do so. Putting our trust in someone isn’t something that we do easily. Indeed many of us are only happy when we think we have complete control of our destiny. Yet we know all too well that we can never really know what tomorrow will bring.

I can always remember when I left school, writing out a list of things that I wanted to do and achieve before I was twenty-five. There were two sections to the list firstly the things I was going to achieve no matter what happened and those which I would do my best to achieve.

I was tidying up the other day and found the lists and as I am now nearer forty five than twenty five I decided to see what I had actually achieved.

Out of the twenty-eight things I was definitely going to achieve I had done six. And on the other list of forty-three things I had achieved two. I am not going to tell you what the eight things I had achieved were, but they weren’t very exciting.

The truth is none of us know what the future will be and so it involves an element of trust not only in our friends and family but also in God. We have to trust that God knows what is best for us and that he will direct us.

The journey as a Christian isn’t always easy, but we know that if we do our best to live as Christ taught us and trust in God, then we are following Christ. We will then be reassured that at the end of our journey we will have salvation.

Being a follower isn’t easy because it means we have to trust in another. We have to trust that they know what is best for us and this may not necessarily be what we think is best for us but if we do trust in God then we will get our reward in heaven.
