REFLECTION

Thirty First Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

The Gospel today put me in mind of an incident which happened to me many years ago. When I was eight, the Pope came to Britain, I suppose many of you can remember this. What made it even more exciting for me was the fact the Pope was actually going to celebrate Mass in my Parish. My home Parish being Wembley Park actually had Wembley stadium in it. So we all got very excited. However, as the day got closer I became aware that although we went to Mass every Sunday and I sang in the choir and my mother played in the choir, we weren’t well known enough in the Parish to get tickets to attend the event. Our Parish didn’t get that many tickets anyway, being only a small parish in the middle of a council estate. So although the Pope was actually going to celebrate Mass in my Parish my family would not be able to attend. Not that I’m bitter. I did hope that on that particular day there was going to be thunder, lightning, rain, snow, the whole lot so that everyone with a ticket and wasn’t from the Parish would wish they had stayed at home and allowed me to have the ticket.

Nevertheless, on that particular morning we got up early and headed down to Empire Way hoping to catch a glimpse of the Pope. Now my Father had bought a Polish Solidarity flags for myself and my two sisters to wave. He assured us, that when the Pope saw these flags he would wave at us. Across the road from us, were children with Papal flags, but I was assured that the Pope would wave specifically at me and my two sisters because our flags were better. The Papal entourage eventually arrived, followed by the police on motorbikes and then the Pope in his Pope-mobile and who do you think he waved at? you’ve guessed it, the children holding the Papal flags. For me this was the last straw, and so I muttered some very un-Papal thoughts for which I got a smack and both my sisters were in tears.

Zacchaeus, goes to extreme lengths to get a glimpse of our Lord, climbing a sycamore tree. Despite the crowds, Jesus spots him and has dinner with him. Our Lord spots all of us and he knows each of us better than we know ourselves. It is because of this that although we would love to see him and talk with him as soon as possible in person, of course we know that we can talk to him whenever we want through prayer. We also know that we will see him one day, face to face, when we go to heaven. We won’t need tickets because everyone will be welcomed in, there is no limit to the amount of people heaven can hold, it never gets filled up because heaven is eternal and unlimited. So let us continue to talk to our Lord through prayer each day and then when our time comes to meet him face to face, we will be ready.
