Reflection for the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the year A

In our Gospel, today we are asked to reflect on salt and on light. We all know how salt can enhance the taste of food. Light can guide us through the darkness. Jesus is the light which guides us.

Many years ago, when I was a Scout, I can remember going on a night hike. One of the things we were taught was that we didn’t need torches, all we had to do was to keep looking up into the night sky and then we would gain our night vision. We were in a place called Rickmansworth just north of London, so there were no street lights. It was one of the first times I was amazed by the number of stars in the sky. One of the things I love about Cornwall is that on a clear night we can see the stars.

What is the light of Jesus? The light of Jesus is our guiding light. We feel secure in the light of Jesus as it directs us through life. It is the teaching of Jesus that motivates us to live in imitation of Him. The light of Jesus is God sharing his life and love with us. It is the life of Jesus that is shared with us in the Eucharist: the living bread that has come down from heaven giving life to the world.

Like the stars of the night sky, Jesus’s light guides us. It helps us to see during the dark moments of our lives. He shows a new light to help us gain our “Jesus vision”.

Seeing in a new light, is about seeing in a new perspective, God’s perspective. It is about behaving in a different way. Therefore, let us see in a different light and let our light shine in people’s eyes, so that seeing our good works, they may give praise to God.
