REFLECTION

Homily 3rd Sunday of Easter C

In today’s Gospel, like last Sunday’s Gospel, we hear an account of Jesus appearing to his disciples after the resurrection. This time the disciples are fishing, when they spot Jesus on the shore.

Peter as always reacts attentively and dives into the water. Later in this Gospel, Jesus asks Peter three times if he loves him and Peter answer “Yes”. Jesus asks Peter to look after his sheep, lambs and feed them. He chooses Peter to look after his followers. This may seem strange, because on the night before the Passion, Peter denies Christ three times. Surely he would have been better asking one of the other disciples? Why ask the same person who may well deny him again.

The answer is, we don’t know, all we do know is that Jesus doesn’t always choose the strong to look after his disciples, his flock. More often than not, it is the weak or those that appear to be weak that Jesus chooses. We are all human and all occasionally make mistakes. No one is perfect, sometimes we make the mistake that we look to our Leaders, our Priests and Bishops as superhuman individuals that should never make any mistakes. It is well to remember that they are human just like you and me, and make mistakes just like you and me. We are all Christ’s followers, we are all his disciples and because he has compassion for each one of us, then we need to reflect his example by having compassion for one another.

In the first Reading we see that Peter and the Apostles receive opposition from the high Priest and the Sanhedrin. The Holy Spirit they had received gave them the courage to bear witness to Christ.

In the same way because we all have received the Holy Spirit in Baptism, we too have the courage to bear witness to Christ. As Christians, we will be a much stronger witness to our world if we are united as one community following Christ. So today let us pray for unity and compassion within our Catholic Church and between all Christian Churches.
