**REFLECTION**

Reflection for the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary time Year A

In today’s Gospel, we hear Jesus praying to the Father and thanking him for hiding things from the learned and showing them to children. One would think, from this that in order to understand certain things about our Faith we need to have the minds of children.

In my teaching days, before the election of Pope Benedict, I can remember telling my class that there was a real possibility I could be elected Pope, and if so, I would not be in the next day. The next morning several students looked shocked when they saw me sitting at my desk, they really thought I was going to be elected.

As a child, many of us believed that heaven was a place in the clouds, we knew that Jesus lived there and one day we would go there. It is only as we get older that we may start to question whether it is really there or what it is like and whether we will end up there one day.. Deep down we know that it exists, but nevertheless we still question at times.

So, when we are told in the Gospels that in order to enter the Kingdom of heaven we need to be like little children, it doesn’t mean that we need to regress and start wearing a baseball cap saying that everything is “cool”. What it means is that in some way we need to retain a sense of wonder and awe when we think of God and heaven. We need to leave our cynicism to one side and use our imagination to contemplate the wonders of God.

It is then that our faith will strengthen and our relationship with God will become a step closer.
