**REFLECTION**

In today’s Gospel we hear Jesus warning against false teachers and those who do not practise what they preach. Jesus wants to get the point across that they must continue to follow God, because He is their true leader. He warns against the Pharisees who at that time were lording it over them. They wore fine clothes and always sat in the place of honour, they weren’t interested in others, only themselves and their own self importance.

This particular Gospel always puts me in mind of my very first interview with the Cardinal when I started training to become a Priest. I had to go to Archbishops house and was shown up an enormous staircase to the Cardinal’s waiting room. Which again was very big and impressive. Whilst I was waiting to see Cardinal Hume, I was trying to remember what I was supposed to do when you meet a Cardinal, as I had never met one before. I thought that the Cardinal would probably be in all his robes and be led into the room by his secretary. I was a bit early, only about an hour and half and so when I heard to door open again I thought that I was going to be offered a cup of tea or something. I was just about to get up and say, milk and two sugars when I turned around and thought, this doesn’t look like the secretary and after a while I figured out that this is in fact the Cardinal. He wasn’t dressed in all his robes, rather he was wearing a cardigan and pretty ordinary clothes and before I had a chance to worry about what title to call him he took me into his office and we had started the interview.

There are many people in our world today who would do anything to improve their own self importance, they look after themselves and forget about others. They may well wear all the right up to date clothes and say the right things to the right people. Very often it is these people that always seem to get what they want. People get promoted in their jobs they get the nice houses the fast cars, but what good is all this if they are not happy within themselves? If people don’t care for others then they will find life at the top is very lonely.

The truth is that there is nothing wrong in wanting to achieve things, but when it is done at the expense of others then we are in trouble, because we become just like Pharisees and begin to Lord it over other. It isn’t what people are like on the outside that matters it is what they are like on the inside that counts. Happiness can never be a purely external thing to be truly happy it has to come from within.

So let us pray that we may not discount others simply because of the way they look. Let us always strive to be an opening and welcoming community of believers.
