REFLECTION

Epiphany of the Lord

This Christmas my Sister came to stay with me and our Christmas shopping reminded me very much of the Epiphany scene. We were to go shopping and my instructions were “grab that trolley and follow me!” I obeyed. Following her not knowing what I would find or where we would go but that there was a true purpose to this jaunt, and a wonderful Christmas feast to be had at the end of it.

Today is a day when we celebrate the completion of the Christmas story. Up until now the birth of Christ has only been witnessed by his parents, a few shepherds and some animals. All these characters are local to the area. Today we celebrate the arrival of visitors from the East. Wise men followed the star to Bethlehem and the stable, we do not know much about the visitors but we are told that they were wise men bearing gifts of Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh.

Of course, these gifts were prophetic, Gold – symbolising the Kingship of Christ, Frankincense – a priesthood of Christ and Myrrh – pointing to his suffering and death for us.

Had the wise men not visited the Christ child we might never have had the complete Christmas story. We also hear that King Herod is not too happy about the thought of another King challenging his Kingdom. He appears to strong and in control but inside he is scared of being challenged.

Christ on the other hand appears to be a defenceless baby lying in a manger, but within he is immensely strong and full of love and compassion for everyone. So today let us celebrate that thanks to the wise men, we too are represented at the crib and we too are witnesses to the love and compassion of Christ.
