**REFLECTION**

Reflection for the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday Year C

I’m sure for many of us when we read this Gospel passage, we think how lucky these ‘seventy-two others’ were. They are sent out by Jesus; they have the knowledge that Jesus is behind everything they do. Yet they are shocked when they are successful. As Christians we should never be shocked by the power of God. Very often, if I can’t think of anything to say, or my mind goes blank just before I am about to give an address, I will say “Over to you Lord!” If we prepare ourselves fully to do something then can rely on God to help us. I can remember being told by an old school teacher; “Fail to prepare, prepare to fail.”

Preparation can take many forms, for me I will read the Gospel for Sunday early in the week and then think carefully about what I am going to say in my homily. I will bring that Gospel reading into my daily prayer. One way we can all prepare, is through prayer allowing God into our conversation and our thoughts. Sometimes He will act without us even realising.

Many years ago, when I was first ordained, I went to do my first set of sick visits in Hammersmith, I decided to wear my rollerblades as I had quite a big area to cover. At Mass the following Sunday I received a lot of negative comments from parishioners informing me that it was not seemly for a Priest to be seen on roller blades. Then just as I was about to go back into the presbytery, a Mother and Son came over and the Mother said that her Son had decided to come back to Mass, because he had heard that there was Priest who wore roller blades, she then thanked me and left.

We must never doubt the power of God to work through us. Ninety-nine parishioners may have been unimpressed, but my roller blades brought one young man back to the fold.
