REFLECTION

Reflection for Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time Year C

In today’s Gospel Jesus tells his Disciples to put out into deep water. For many this would be a very nerve-racking experience. I can remember as a child being intrigued by the diving pool at our local leisure centre, all we were ever told was that it was very deep. As a child it looked frightening. When I grew up, I decided that I had to dive in to it from the lower diving board. I mustered up all my courage and jumped, although I had my eyes closed, I hoped for the best. I then went to the next board up and dived again. Then there was the top board, I ran jumped and dived. I have never dived from it again and have no intention of ever doing it again.

The Disciples show great trust in Jesus by putting out into deep water especially as they weren’t expecting to do that. When they show their trust in Jesus they are repaid by catching a large number of fish. One can only imagine how amazed they were. Jesus then informs the disciples that from that moment they will be catching Men.

Occasionally in life we can wait patiently for a miracle to happen. We can sometimes long for a miracle. But we can never know the mind or the workings of God. The Apostles trust Jesus. We too, who trust in God can be assured that every prayer we pray, is heard. Every Sunday we partake in the miracle of receiving the Eucharist into our hearts and souls. This is our spiritual food for the journey through life. We can sometimes be blinded to the miracles that happen in our lives, because they may not be the miracles that we think we need. We are confined by the world in which we live. God who answers our prayers is not. When we are asked to trust in God let us, like the Apostles, be prepared to, “put out into deep water....” Because God loves us and is always with us.
