REFLECTION

Today we celebrate God, we celebrate our Parish community and we remember that we are made in the image and likeness of God.

When we think of the Most Holy Trinity we can’t help but think of three separate people. God the Father, in heaven controlling everything, God the Son, Jesus our loving saviour and the Holy Spirit, God with us now. This is of course incorrect, because we can only think in terms of human constructs. The Trinity is heavenly, something we can never hope to grasp, until we ourselves become heavenly.

As a community, we can only dream how we can be perfect. The example we have is God, the perfect community. The Greeks tried to describe the Trinity by using the explanation of Perichoresis. For the Greeks, Perichoresis is a heavenly dance, it is danced by Father, Son and Holy Spirit and is so perfect, it is one. I’m sure we have all seen ballroom dancers, when they dance to the best of their ability, they appear to be one person gliding across the dance floor. The perfect heavenly dance is for the Trinity.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to baptise in the “The name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” In Baptism, we are baptised into the perfection of God the Sacred Community. In our eyes, we can never be perfect, but God knows our potential, because he created us to be like him. He creates us, forgives us and guides us out of love. One day we will go to our loving creator and then we will understand what perfection is, until that day we can only dream about the beauty and perfection of God.
