Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I enjoyed being with you in the parish a couple of weeks ago. Thank you for your warm hospitality and welcome, and for all that you are doing to build up the life of the parish.

I am writing to let you know that, as well as being your priest here in Newquay, I have asked Fr. Anthony to take on the oversight of the communities in Perranporth and St. Agnes, from this Easter. This follows Fr. Brian Stevens’ resignation from Ecclesiastical Office, in order to exercise his priestly ministry in a slightly different key at this particular stage of his life. I want to thank Fr. Brian for his dedicated service in those communities.

Whilst this will mean no change to the weekend mass times in Newquay, it does mean that Fr. Anthony will be more stretched as he takes on these extra pastoral responsibilities. I want to thank him for his generosity in this regard and to ask you all to continue to give him good support with the added workload. I know that you will do that generously.

We are fortunate that presently there are three men in priestly formation. But we must pray for more. That prayer and encouragement is vital, and I know you will respond generously to it.

I know, too, that you will continue to work well locally to ensure that our Catholic faith is lived with great vibrancy in this part of the Diocese. Wishing each of you, many graces and blessings during this Holy Season of Lent and with my kindest wishes and prayers.
