## REFLECTION

### Easter Sunday

Today we reach the third day of the Triduum, the three most important days in the year of the Church. Jesus risen from the dead. Jesus conquering the biggest fear of all humans, “death”.

Today we still celebrate the Resurrection wherever we are and remember we are still in communion with one another.

Jesus rose from the dead to show that we have nothing to fear from death and that human life is to be cherished. Let us pray that this present time when we journey not knowing what tomorrow will bring, will come to an end soon. We pray for all those that have died and for those who mourn their loss.

We also pray that the Resurrection of Jesus may give us the courage to journey through this time in the knowledge that he is by our side.
