**REFLECTION**

Reflection for the Fourth Sunday of Easter

During the week I was asked a question by a sixth former. He asked me, “Was it necessary for human survival that God must exist?” It took me a while to formulate an answer as I had been getting ready to travel back to Newquay.

My first response was to say that It would be a very sad world if he didn’t, or, how do explain our existence. Instead I asked the student who was the most influential person in his life? When I have asked this question before, usually, the answer will be “My Mum,” or, “My Dad,” or a family member, or someone who cares for them. I asked the student to imagine life without that person who loves you so very much. Imagine a world where there was no love. For many of us this is incomprehensible. As Christians we believe that God is love, if this is the case and there is love in the world, then he must exist, because if He doesn’t where does love come from?

As Christians we listen to voice of the Good Shepherd, because he loves us. The Good Shepherd leads his flock to safe pasture because of his love for us.

In order to know true love and happiness it is necessary to have a figure who helps us to understand why we have these emotions and how to use them. For us this is God. The student seemed to accept my answer.
