REFLECTION

In today’s Gospel we hear Jesus telling us to be ready to meet the Lord because we do not know when we will eventually meet him. Whether we live to see the second coming or whether it’s when we go up to heaven after we die. None of us know the day or the hour, so therefore we must always be ready.

Today is a day when we are asked to remember all those who have died during the two world wars and indeed those who have died in all the wars. But it is also a day when we look to the future, whilst learning from the past. One of the most important lessons that we learn, is the dignity of human life and that human life is precious.

Many may say that the future should be left to the younger generations to deal with, but of course this is not true. Each one of us, no matter what age have the responsibility to help bring about the future of the Church. It is the job of everyone, to help with the mission of the Church. It is up to each of us to keep the light of Christ shining in our world today.

So let’s continue to follow the mission of Christ, because it is when we do this, that we will make sure, that when our time comes we shall be truly ready to meet the Lord.
