REFLECTION

Homily Seventh Sunday of Easter Year B

In the Gospel today we hear Jesus asking his Father to look after and watch over his disciples once he returns back to Him. In many ways Jesus is telling his Father that he has kept his part of the deal by training up the disciples and making them ready, it is now up to the Father to take over responsibility.

It is always worth remembering that when we pray in the Eucharist or in daily life when we say the Our Father or the Hail Mary. We are not actually praying to Jesus or Mary rather we are praying to God the Father. We are only asking for the help or intercession of Jesus or Mary in our prayers to the Father. It is the Father who sent Jesus and it is the Father who sends the Holy Spirit. In many ways therefore it makes sense that Jesus does speak to his Father, asking for help and telling him what he has done.

I am always reminded of a scene in one of the ‘Carry on Films’. Whereby, the cast are working in a Toilet Factory and towards the end of the film, the Foreman is promoted to Manager and he protests greatly saying he is a worker from the working class and doesn’t want to, or never will be management. However, promoted he is, and so people come to him asking for help and he keeps saying to them, look I am not the manager or management go and ask the boss. But of course this doesn’t work because the workforce know him and trust him, he has worked like them and therefore must be able to help them. Besides, they can talk to him because they know him better than the boss.

It’s a bit the same with Jesus we know him because he has been one of us, we know him because we have a vague idea what he looks like, the same with Mary. So whilst we can ask for their help when talking to the Father. It is the Father who grants our prayers, it is Father to whom we pray and ask for help.
