REFLECTION

Homily 2nd Sunday Year B

In the Gospel today we hear that Jesus in continuing to choose his disciples and each one who decides to become a follower then tells others about who they have met; the Messiah. The amazing thing is that when each one is called to follow Jesus they don’t seem to say “Oh well, hang on I’ll see if I can be your disciple on Monday and Friday but I’m a bit busy at the moment” or they don’t say “Well leave it with me and I will see what I can do”. They seem to immediately take up the mission to become a follower of Jesus. They knew that this was a mission and a vocation that had to be taken up immediately, it wasn’t something that could be left to the future.

Today is Peace Sunday when we pray for peace in our world and now, more than ever, is a time when we should pray for peace and pray that our world leaders see that war is not the only means to solve a dispute. It can be easy sometimes to pray for world peace and in the future to pray that one day we may live in a world without war, but we also need to live in the present and pray for peace in our world today at this precise moment. We have to be like the disciples and take up our mission for peace now, not next year or the year after.

It is the mission of every Christian to work for peace and reconciliation. It is a mission which we are given at Baptism and then take up ourselves at our Confirmation. Jesus himself said that he came to bring peace not war. Each one of us is given a vocation by God to live as a follower of Christ and spread his Good News to others, that is our first vocation. We have many other different vocations as well but, this is the first and most important one. So we must never tire in praying and working for peace in our time.

With this in mind, today let us pray for all those who live in the threat of war, those who undergo persecution for their Faith and also for those who work for the unity and peace among nations and help the victims of war.
