REFLECTION

Reflection for Fifteenth Sunday year C

In today’s Gospel which is very familiar to us we are told to always expect the unexpected. The Samaritan is the last person you would expect to help the wounded man. The Samaritans and the Jews did not get on, so for Jesus to mention a Samaritan as being a hero will not have gone down well.

In life we can’t always choose the people we meet or the places where we live. Yet very often we can be pleasantly surprised. My aunt was visiting Newquay recently from Ireland. I offered to take her up to Port Isaac to see where “Doc Martin” was being filmed. When I asked her if she wanted to go, her answer was “Doc who?” She then informed me that she didn’t think that the programme would be her cup of tea. Any way up we went. When we were walking down the hill into the village, she was complaining that there were too many hills in Cornwall. Anyway, we had a lovely afternoon and saw some of the filming happening. In the end she didn’t want to leave. When we returned home, I had to search IPlayer to get the complete first series and ever since she has been watching it non-stop.

New experiences aren’t always appealing to us. Yet how often are we surprised when we actually enjoy them. The Samaritan helps the wounded man and helps him to get better. May we never be shocked when someone shows us kindness.
