**REFLECTION**

Reflection for Twenty-Eighth Sunday year B

In today’s Gospel Jesus helps his disciples to reflect on what it is to be wise. Jesus refers to the Ten Commandments and then gives the image of a camel trying to pass through the eye of a needle. We do of course know that the eye of a needle refers to a gateway into Jerusalem, where a laden camel cannot go through. It is only when the camel is free from all baggage that it can fit. To enter heaven, we need to free ourselves from all the riches we have in life.

I am put in mind of a class I taught. We had several students who professed to be leaders of the class, they were the ones everyone looked up to. We had an issue in the class over a new student who had joined, so I took everyone to the Chapel and we had a class discussion. The class leaders weren’t happy with the new student and let their feelings be known. The discussion began to deteriorate and I tried to help focus the debate, but this didn’t work. The new student asked if she could speak. She said “Perhaps we should listen to Father as he might know what he is talking about.”

Peter listens to Jesus in the Gospel but isn’t too happy with what he hears, Jesus explains, but doesn’t soften his stance. It is hard to listen to people when they are trying to help us. It is even harder at times to be the one who tries to give the good advice.
