REFLECTION

Homily Fifteenth Sunday Year B

In our Gospel today and indeed in all the readings, we hear our Lord sending people out to be missionaries of his Word to people everywhere. In the Gospel he sends out the twelve disciples and instructs them not to take any belongings with them apart from the sandals on their feet. Jesus reassures them that they can rely on the Holy Spirit to provide them, with all that they would need. Jesus gives his disciples specific instructions on their ministry and how to go about preaching. It is worth remembering that not all the disciples would have been totally adept with all the attributes needed for this ministry. They all had different strengths, some would have been good at preaching, others would have had the gift of healing, others the gift of praying, etc.

We, too, are a bit like the Apostles in that we all have different gifts and talents we are not all good at the same thing, yet we are all called to preach and bear witness to our faith.

It always puts me in mind of when I use to play rugby at school. The team would walk on to the pitch and the difference in size between the backs and forwards was quite big. I could never see how we would win with such a mixed bag. Yet when we were organized and each playing in their designated position on the pitch, we performed well. We each had our position. Some of us were faster than others some were able to catch better than others some were good at kicking some were good at tackling. When all these talents were combined we achieved amazing results.

The Apostles were similar to this - as a team they were brilliant, individually there were many weaknesses. It is similar with us in the Church, individually we function, but together as a team we perform in a much stronger and effective way. So today, let us pray that in our parish, our community and our churches, we will always try and work together and show the people of Cornwall the love and compassion of God. By doing this we will ensure that our parish will be here for many more years to come.
