**REFLECTION**

Reflection for Twenty-fourth Sunday year C

In today’s Gospel, Jesus tells us three Parables. Three Parables that are easy to visualise and easy for us to understand. Now usually, my thoughts would be immediately drawn to the Parable of the Prodigal Son as it is probably the one most of us have heard before and one that is quite explicit. However, I am drawn to the first Parable we hear today, that of the Lost Sheep.

I was reminded of what a teacher of mine told me many years ago. She told us that whenever we leave the house or a group of friends, we should always try to leave on good terms, because none of us know what the future may hold. My family have never been into hugging very much, a handshake is the most we have ever managed. When I went and toured Southern Africa as an eighteen-year-old, we shook hands before I left. I have been on many journeys and we would always depart with a handshake. However, when I left for Cornwall, we all hugged, I was quite surprised, I only assume they thought I was going to real danger and they never knew when they might see me again. When I asked, “Why are we hugging?” I was told that Cornwall was so beautiful they knew that I would never again want to work in London. Every time I leave to come back to Cornwall now, we hug.

The Parable of the Prodigal Son tells us that no matter what happens to us the Father will always welcome us back into the fold. He always awaits us with arms opened wide. He always welcomes us back with a hug.

Let us never forget the words of that wise teacher to make sure that when leave the house or a group of friends we leave on good terms, because we don’t know what the future holds. We must never forget that no matter what happens in our lives, our loving Father will never abandon us and will always search us out.
