REFLECTION

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year A

How often in life do we hear somebody say “What would Jesus do”? In today’s Gospel Jesus seems to be somewhat harsh. Jesus seems to be sticking to the rules. He reminds us that he has come to fulfil the Prophets and the Law, not abolish it.

Jesus is reminding us to keep our promises to each other. If we promise something we should do our best to fulfil the promise. Sometimes we can mean to do something and have every intention of carrying it out, but, then something happens and we fail. Time and time again in the Gospels, Jesus shows compassion to those who try their best to lead a good life and then fail. Let us never forget that Jesus always uses compassion when dealing with people who try their best.

This Gospel also reminds us that Jesus wants us to live in harmony and therefore, laws, not only have to be kept, but, we need to understand why they are there. If they are to help us lead a good way of life according to the teachings of the Gospel, then we have to try our best to abide by them.

If anyone asks us the question, “What do we think Jesus would do about a situation”? The answer is “We don’t know”. All we know is, he may not act in a way we would expect. But we can be sure that he will always act in a way that shows compassion.
