## REFLECTION

Homily 15th Sunday Year A

Today is one of those Sundays when we don’t only hear a parable told to us by Jesus, but he also explains it to us. It explains what he is trying to say and why he is saying it.

One of the many placements I did as a trainee Priest was one out in the countryside. Among the parishioners I had to visit, quite a few were farmers. And being brought up in London, this was one of the first occasions that I had actually got close to many farm animals, especially farm dogs.

On one particular day I had to go and visit a farm. As I entered the farm I was chased by the dog for a while before eventually making it to the front door. I rang the doorbell several times, being watched very carefully by the dog who was standing guard on me making sure that I wasn’t going to make a quick getaway. There was still no answer, so I gradually made my way on the side of the house to the garden at the back and saw someone in a greenhouse at the bottom of the garden.

When I went in I could see that the person I thought was the farmer’s wife was planting seeds, so I asked where her husband was and she told me she didn’t have a husband. Then I asked where the farmer was, to which she replied she was the farmer.

What struck me though was the way in which she was planting these particular seeds. Each one was carefully positioned the right distance apart and at the right depth and then very gently covered over with soil. And it was at that point that I got a very different vision of the parable of the sower. In the parable, the sower does scatter the seed but he does position it, because the seed is his word and we are the soil. As so the word of God is positioned within us. Rather like the lady farmer the word is planted carefully within us. But then it is up to us how we receive. It is not so much the planting of the word that is the gamble. It is how the person receives it. Jesus brought the Word into the world and each one of us is given the chance to hear and proclaim the Word. The Word is planted within us. It is up to us what we do with it.
