REFLECTION

Reflection for the Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary time

The parable of the mustard seed is a familiar one to us. Jesus reminds us that the seed of faith which is planted in our hearts needs to be nurtured. It needs to be looked after, this will enable it to grow.

This parable reminds me of the times I have been given presents from relatives and friends – gifts which at the time seem to have no use. One Christmas, one of my eccentric relatives gave me a pebble, agreed, it had been polished and had a boat painted on it, but none the less it was a pebble. I wasn’t too impressed. However, over the course of time I saw this gift in a different light. I still have this pebble today because it is useful. It can be used as a weight or as a doorstop, I use it to hammer picture hooks into my wall, I have even used it to keep a window shut.

The gifts and graces we have been given by God can sometimes seem to be useless for us and we ask why do we need them? Yet there will come a time when we do understand their relevance. All the gifts we have can make sense when we use them to help build up the Kingdom of God. They can be of so much value make when we use them to help develop Faith in the lives of others, as well as our own lives. No gift is ever worthless. The seed of faith is planted in all of us, even if some still need to realise and nurture it. It is the smallest of seeds yet it can grow and transform our lives.
