**REFLECTION**

Second Week of Ordinary Time

In today’s Gospel we hear the witness of John the Baptist, in John’s Gospel this is where Jesus makes his entrance, following on from John’s mission. It is a dramatic entrance with Jesus appearing as if from nowhere and being spotted by John as the Saviour, the Lamb of God. By identifying Jesus as the Lamb of God, John hands on the baton and leaves it up to Jesus, to begin his ministry from then.

Being a Christian and a follower of Christ is rather like a relay race. The first leg is run by John the Baptist, he then hands on the baton to Jesus who runs the second leg. Jesus then passes it on to each one of us to run the third leg. It is up to us to keep the Gospel message alive and to let people know, by our example, the love of Christ. We have to prepare the way for the fourth and final leg which will be again run by Jesus, which is when he comes again on the last day. Then the race finishes, when each of us will be with our Father in heaven.

We are at present running this third leg. We too have been filled with the Holy Spirit, through our Baptism and through our Confirmation we have accepted the mission of Christ. This mission will be different for each one of us, because we are all unique and all good at different things. We also have different callings. Whatever our gifts or callings may be, it is up to us to use them to help bring about God’s Kingdom here on earth. It is up to us to carry out our mission to the best of our ability. One day we will hand on the baton to Jesus once more for a final time, let us be able to say that we have done our best.
