**REFLECTION**

In today’s Gospel we are reminded to use our God given talents, which we should use to help each other, not just ourselves. Our Gospel also reminds us that one day Jesus will come again.

When I was a child I always imagined that in heaven there was a big book and in this book my entire life was mapped out. Every day I spent here on earth was already written down. However, the Gospel today reminds us, that this is not the case. By using our talents to their full potential, to help us and each other, we are ensuring that when we meet the Lord, we can give full account of our lives and be proud of what we have achieved.

The first Parish Priest which I served with was a former lecturer and occasionally he would tell me great stories of the students he had taught. I remember one lunchtime he came in and announced that another one of his past students had just been made a Bishop. I said congratulations, but rather than looking happy he looked sad. Then during the course of the meal he told me that he would have loved to be a Bishop himself and that he thought he would make a good job of it. He was forgetting the fact that he had taught at least three men who were now Bishops.

Sometimes life can fool us into thinking that the only way to succeed is to move up the ladder of whatever profession we are in. I said to this Priest, “Isn’t it better that the Church has these Bishops, because if you had been made Bishop it would only have one. You!” He of course agreed. His gift was education and teaching. Their gift was leadership. Let us never underestimate our gifts and let us use them to their full potential because, it is in this way that our talents will incur a better interest than a bank could ever give.
