REFLECTION

Second Sunday of Ordinary time Year C

In today’s Gospel we hear of a Wedding in Cana. Unusually we don’t hear about the Bride and Groom, we don’t know who they are, or how Mary knows them. In John’s Gospel this will be where Jesus will perform his first miracle or as John calls it, gives his first sign. So why does it centre around a wedding? For John it mirrors the wedding between God and humanity.

Having ministered at many weddings, the focus is usually the love between the Bride and Groom. At a recent wedding I was ministering at in London, the Bride and Groom chose to walk down the aisle together, it was a great sign of love and equality between the two.

For John, the Bridegroom is Jesus and the Bride is the Church, The Bridegroom comes to serve the Church, and through the spilling of his blood will sacrifice himself so that God and the Church may be married together in the great wedding feast of heaven.

The six stone water jars are there to cleanse the guests, through turning this water into wine Jesus reminds us that he will cleanse us through his blood. This will enable us to drink the new wine which he will leave us in the Eucharist.

When we receive the body and blood of Jesus in Mass it reminds us in a special way of the love that God has for each one of us. A love which one day will reunite us with God in heaven.
