REFLECTION

In today’s Gospel, we again hear a parable based around a vineyard. The message we get from it is that no matter when we turn to the Lord, he is always ready to listen and take us back into his flock.

I guess that there can be nothing worse than to have people push in front of us when we are queuing up for something. It can get really infuriating, when for instance you go for a dental appointment, arrive in plenty of time and the person who is before you, arrives ten minutes late, rushes in, and you then have to wait longer for your appointment. Or when you wait twenty minutes for a tube train in the rush hour, then it comes, people who have arrived after you push and shove their way on past you and you have to wait for the next train.

So, you can imagine what it must have been like for the worker in the vineyard who had worked all day and yet only gets paid the same as the one who worked for a very short period of time. To us none of these scenarios seem very fair or just, yet this is what the Gospel says and then it finishes with a very familiar saying that the last will be first and the first will be last. The message that Our Lord is trying to get across is that in the eyes of the Lord, we are all equal. He has no favourites. All that he asks, is that we live according to his commandments and when we need to ask for his forgiveness, we shall receive the same treatment as everyone else, when we eventually go to our eternal reward in Heaven.

Jesus has no favourites he came to offer everyone the possibility of Salvation.

There is no club class, business class and economy class in Heaven, there is no first or second class in Heaven, there is only one class which is Salvation, we could call this the Paradise Class.
