REFLECTION

TWENTY NINTH SUNDAY – YEAR B

In the Gospel we have just listened to, we hear James and John asking for promotion, to a special place in Jesus’s favour. They try to get their request in before any of the other Apostles and we see that the other Apostles are indignant with them. The Apostles disdain of James and John was possibly because on the one hand they were thinking about asking for the same special treatment themselves but also looking at James and John and thinking why they thought themselves so important to ask for special treatment in the first place.

Jesus answers James and John by asking them if they can drink from the same cup as he will have to drink and can they be baptised with the same baptism with which he will be baptised. Jesus knew at this point that he was going to have to suffer and his disciples found this increasingly difficult to deal with.

The first reading shows us that Christ does not live separate from us. He does not sit on a golden throne in Heaven waiting to judge us, he is with us the whole time. This is most evident whenever we attend Mass and receive the Eucharist this is when we show others that we are in communion with one another and with God.

Jesus calls each one of us into companionship on the journey to God. It is a journey that will have many ups and downs when we will have to endure hardship and suffering and we may well be asked to sacrifice a great deal along the way. The consolation we have is that Jesus has walked the path before us he has experienced what it is to be human.

I am always reminded of a saying a Gaelic football coach used to give us before we played a match. He said that the match may go our way or, it may not, but give of your best and at the end whether you win the match or not you will all be winners. It’s a shame he used to forget reiterating that saying at the end of any match we lost!

We walk along our journey of life with Christ in the knowledge that one day we too may have salvation, because, he has already drunk from the cup and received his baptism of suffering and in doing so, won for us salvation.
