REFLECTION

Reflection 4th Sunday of Easter year B

In today’s Gospel we are being asked to listen to the Good Shepherd.

We know that we can trust Jesus because he laid down his life for us and he did this out of love. How often in life do people give us advice or try to help us, simply because they care for us or they love us, and how often do we listen?

In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter reminds those assembled that the good work the Apostles are doing is done in the name of Jesus. He wants the people to look and listen to what he is doing and saying. One of the most annoying things in life is when we try to help someone and they don’t listen, or, when we do a good turn and we are never thanked.

The amount of times as a teacher I would try to help a student by telling them to revise for an exam, I tried every way possible to make it interesting and exciting, only for them not to bother. Then when the exam was over, to have them to come and say to me; “I wish I had listened to you!”

As a Priest I can remember being annoyed at being moved to a new Parish. I vented my anger to a brother Priest who simply said; “Sometimes the Bishop does know what he is doing!” Just because we don’t like the advice or don’t want to act on it, it doesn’t mean it’s not the right thing to do.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd and today we give thanks for all the Shepherds in our lives who try to help us and try to keep us safe.
