REFLECTION

Sixteenth Sunday Year B

How often in life would we like to run away and hide somewhere. In today’s Gospel Jesus wants to take his Apostles off somewhere to have a rest. He knows they are tired. Unfortunately, the people know where he is taking his Apostles and follows them. Jesus takes pity on them and stay to teach the crowds.

It always amazes me that no matter where I go in the world I always seem to meet someone I know, or, a friend of a friend. During my teaching career, I said Mass at my home parish in Wembley which was a good distance away from where I was teaching. Unfortunately, during the service the incense fell on to the carpet and set it on fire. Luckily a parishioner appeared with sand and a dustpan and brush. The next morning, I was taking the register in school and one of the girls told the class that I had set a Church on fire! I asked her how she knew this and she said, “My Mum’s friend’s aunt, has a sister who has a friend, who has a friend and her husband’s best friend was at the Mass!” I just looked at her with my mouth open and said, “I don’t believe it!”

How often do we use the expression, “It’s a small World.” Jesus realises this and so doesn’t say to the crowd, “Go away!” But I would imagine he lets the Apostles rest. As we Christians we realise the importance of community. The Second Vatican Council reminds us that we are the “The Body of Christ.” As a community we represent Christ on earth.
