REFLECTION

Second Sunday of Easter Year A

In today’s Gospel we hear about the resurrection of Jesus, on the first day of the week he appears to the disciples later in the evening. This is why our Sabbath day is Sunday and not Saturday like the Jewish religion. Every Sunday for us is a day of the resurrection. When Jesus appears to the disciples one of their number is missing, Thomas is not there.

How many of us would like to have Jesus appear to us, it would put to rest any doubts, if we have any, about our Faith.

I love to hear stories about my grandfathers, I never met them because they had died before I was born, but through the stories I have heard I feel as if I know them very well.
