REFLECTION

HOMILY SIXTEENTH SUNDAY YEAR A

Today’s Gospel is a bit like waiting for a bus in London. The crowds have waited to hear Jesus speak to them in parables and then three come along all at once. We also have a Gospel for the second week running which refers to seeds and a sower. The one to which my attention was drawn, was the parable of the good seed and the darnel. Again, just like last week, Jesus explains the parable to us, that in the world there is good and bad. The son of man plants the good seed and then while everyone is asleep the darnel is planted by the enemy.

Now being a very amateur gardener, the one thing that I notice when you plant a flower, a herb or a bush, is that within what seems a matter of minutes, weeds group up around it. If you care for the plant and water it and remove the weeds, the then the flower will grow, but even if you fail to remove the weeds the flower always grow to be bigger and brighter than the weeds.

The world in which we live, has many temptations which makes us stray from our Faith and our trust in God. Yet Jesus looks after us. He too gives us nourishment in the Eucharist. He enables us to have the strength to spread the word. Later on we hear that the Kingdom of Heaven is like the mustard seed and goes from being the smallest seed to be the biggest bush. Each one of us has the seed of Faith planted in us and that seed has the ability to grow and grow, God nourishes this through the Eucharist. It is up to us to allow the word to bloom within us, and let it show forth in everything we do.
