REFLECTION

Reflection for Twenty-first Sunday year A

In today’s Gospel, we hear Jesus calling Peter and saying that he will give him the ‘Keys to the Kingdom of Heaven’. He also asks his Disciples, “Who do people say the Son of Man is?” One would think that this is a relatively easy question, yet only one can identify Jesus as the Son of God. By giving the Keys to Peter, Jesus symbolises that this is what the Disciples will have to profess as they go on their mission. They will have to preach that Jesus is the Son of God.

When the Keys are handed over, so is the Mission. It is a Mission that has been handed on to us. When I was ordained as a Deacon I was handed the book of the Gospel and told to preach the Word.
