REFLECTION

Reflection for the Third Sunday in Ordinary time year A

We celebrate the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul, an event which completely transformed the Church from being a local Church to being a worldwide Church. St Paul travelled throughout Turkey, Greece and then finally ended up in Rome. Whilst travelling, St. Paul founded communities in the towns and villages he visited and so the Good News of Jesus became known, well beyond the boundaries of Israel. He kept in touch with these communities by writing letters.

In the letter, we hear this morning, Paul is speaking to the people of Corinth, we hear that Paul is warning against division within Christianity. Even at this early stage of the Church’s history Christians were battling against each other. There have always been disputes about the best way to follow Jesus. On the one hand, it is good that the Gospels challenge us and challenge us in different ways, because we are all different, it shows that God is very much alive in our lives. However, we should always strive for unity and common ground within the diversity.

I can always remember when I was at school and met my girlfriend’s parents for the first time. I was shocked when this kind and gentle girl turned into a tyrant with her parents. She was shouting at them and ordering them about. I can remember thinking at the time, that I was glad I was seeing this side of her then! When we left, I asked her why she was so nasty to her parents? She just said “I know! But we love each other really.”

In today’s Gospel, we hear Jesus calling the first of his disciples, all very different people with different ideas, yet they all agree to follow Jesus. They are united by the fact that they are Jesus’ disciples, yet they are all very different. It is only through accepting each other’s diversity that we can ever hope for unity.
