EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR A

In today’s Gospel Jesus reminds his followers about the danger of having two Masters. God must come first and be our sole Master. He also tells them to concentrate on the present as they can’t really be sure what will happen tomorrow.

It puts me in mind of an incident which happened to me. I was preparing for parents evening in a school in Sunbury, near Twickenham. One of the students came to my desk after class and asked what kind of a report I was going to give to her parents. I said, “What do you think I should say”? She replied, “Well I will just warn you that my Father is six foot four and is a black belt in Karate and gets upset if anyone criticises me”. I got very little sleep that night, and spent most of the next day thinking of what I was going to say. When parents evening started, she was the first over to my desk, she said “Daddy is just coming”. When he arrived, he was about five foot five, he sat down and said, “Thank you for teaching my daughter, I know she is a handful and will give her all the help you need in trying to get her to do her work”. She sat beside him grinning.

It’s true that we can waste so much time panicking about events we cannot control. We very often worry needlessly. Jesus asks us to pray and trust in God. We can’t always control the future, but we know that when we pray, God listens. There is a line in the Serenity Prayer which says, “God grant me the grace to accept the things I cannot change”.

The one Master we have is God, and God looks after his people. When we pray, God listens. Perhaps the next time we are unsure about a future event, instead of wasting time worrying, let us turn to God and pray that line from the Serenity Prayer.
