REFLECTION

Reflection Third Sunday of Easter Year A

In today’s Gospel we hear the account of Jesus appearing to two of his disciples on the road to Emmaus. It probably seems strange to us that neither of them recognise Jesus, we know he has his resurrected body, but surely his own disciples would recognise him, yet they don’t, it’s not until they sit down to eat and Jesus blesses and breaks the bread that they recognise him and the minute they do he disappears from their sight.

Many years ago when I was in a religious order training to be a monk we would occasionally go on retreat to Devon. One afternoon we took part in what the Prior called an “Emmaus walk.” He drove us to a deserted piece of coastline and said that he would collect us again in an hour further up the coast. First of all, we moaned about the training, then we discussed why we thought we were being called to Priesthood and how God played a part in our decision. The Prior told us that God was with us during the walk.

Our lives are an Emmaus walk, because we journey with Jesus. We are never left alone. We won’t always recognise him but he is there. There will be times that we really feel his presence, when we feel we can almost touch him.

For us the presence of the Lord is especially present during the celebration of the Eucharist. One of the main actions which takes place during the Mass is when the Priest breaks the bread, which is for us a sign that this really is the Body of Christ. At present it is only the Priest that is able to receive the Eucharist, but we all share in Spiritual Communion with Jesus. We pray for the day that we may all gather round the Altar again and receive the Body of Christ into our hearts
