REFLECTION

Reflection for the Sixth Sunday of Easter Year C

“If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my father will love him,”

In today’s Gospel we are reminded about the Love that God has for his people. In our reading from the Acts of the Apostles we hear that the early Church are getting ready to send a delegate to what will become the Council of Jerusalem, which is the first such meeting in the history of the Church. The last such council of this type that was held was the Second Vatican Council which was held in the sixties.

In the Gospel we are told that the Advocate of The Holy Spirit will be sent to the Apostles so that they will be able to spread the love of God to the world. To this day we know that the Holy Spirit still guides us and our Church. The Second Vatican Council was unusual in that it was not called to discuss one specific issue, rather, it was called to discuss the future of the Church in the modern world. To this day, some people may not like all the recommendations of the Council, but we have to believe that the Holy Spirit was at work when decisions were made and continues to guide us today. We need to remain loyal to St Peter.

Change is never easy, in fact, it is one of the hardest things we ever have to work through. The Church has its doctrines and traditions and on the whole these will never change, but it also has the mission to spread the love of God to our World today. This is a mission that we have as well. We are the “Living Stones” and the Holy Spirit dwells in us.
