REFLECTION

Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A

Today again, just like last Sunday, we seem to be inundated with parables. Our Lord tells us one parable after another, explaining what the Kingdom of heaven is like. In the first parable, we are told that the Kingdom of heaven is like treasure which someone finds and then hides again in a field, he goes and sells everything, then buys the field. If the parable is taken literally then one could be mistaken for thinking that heaven is made from gold and silver and usually when we think of treasure, we think of something that is worth a great deal of money.

Heaven is a treasure which we have, that money cannot possibly buy. It is like Faith, which is a personal treasure which we all have, a very special treasure that grows within us.

I’m always amused by what people refer to as their “treasure”. I can remember visiting a lady a few years ago, I knocked on her door and what sounded like a lion, roared back. I then heard a voice saying, “Come here my little treasure.” When I eventually got to see this “little treasure”, it was a huge dog which didn’t seem very friendly.

Then there were my great aunts who would always welcome me with a big kiss, they would pull my cheek and say; “How’s my little treasure.” People often refer to a treasured friendship, or treasured relationship. Like heaven these are treasures which are important to us, the big dog, those we hold dear and the treasured relationships, these are the kinds of treasure Jesus refers to in the Gospel.

We don’t have a map to find heaven or to find Faith. Faith is something which is God given and grows within us. Heaven is a place where we hope to go to after our life on earth.
