**REFLECTION**

Third Sunday of Ordinary time Year C

In today’s Gospel we hear about the beginning of Jesus’ ministry. Jesus walks into the synagogue and reads from the Prophet Isaiah. Jesus reads out his manifesto, he informs people what He is going to do.

Jesus comes back to the town where he was brought up and informs his own people first. When I was ordained a Priest the Cardinal came to Wembley Park, my home Parish to ordain me. At the Mass there were many people from my past and present and even my Parish Priest to be was in attendance. People who had seen me grow up and seen me as an awkward teenager, Anthony, the postman's son, they were all there. It was powerful to see but also very nerve racking. One of my friends told my sister that she was concerned because at the end of the day; “Her friend Anthony was lying on the floor and committing his life to the Church!”

This is why Jesus has eyes fixed on him in the synagogue, the people are finding it hard to take what he is saying. Can this really be the Jesus the carpenter’s son who they have seen grow up in a small village

We all find change hard, it is never easy. But in life change happens and we have to deal with it. The one certainty we have is that Jesus journeys with us when we have to cope with change. On the whole change is good because it shows that the Good News is active and alive.
