**REFLECTION**

HOMILY TRINITY SUNDAY YEAR B

In the Gospel today, we hear Jesus telling his disciples to go and baptise the nations in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. A phrase which is very familiar to every Christian in the world. It is a phrase which describes the Trinity and so describes God. We are in many ways very blessed to be part of a parish called Holy Trinity, because for us the Trinity is the perfect community. The three persons of the One God, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Of the many descriptions I have heard about the Trinity one of the easiest to understand is to imagine the Trinity as three persons dancing in total harmony as or as many top theologians would say ‘Perichoresis’.

I can always remember very many years ago, when I was still at school, going out on one of my first dates. On this one occasion I wanted to really impress this particular girl. So both my Sisters decided that they would undertake the task of showing me how to dance. We started on the Thursday, by the Saturday we had had a good few rows, our feet were fairly bruised and there had been a certain amount of name calling going on. On top of that we had broken a window, torn a hole in one of the carpets and had trodden on the cat so much that it had decided to move into the greenhouse. Anyway, by the end I was sure that I would be OK and not make a fool of myself. Typically when I eventually went on the date, the first thing the girl said was that she found dancing boring and couldn’t stand dancing at all.

One of the things that you learn with dancing is that it helps if you know what your partner is going to do and when you perfect the routine you do move as one person. It can be great fun and at times very painful when learning to dance.

Building and living in a community can be the same and in the Church we have the example of the perfect Community, we have that vision of perfection which we can all strive towards which is the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity.
