REFLECTION

This Sunday’s Gospel again refers to vineyards. This time the owner sends his two sons into the vineyard to work. The first son refuses but then decides to go and work, the second son says “certainly” but doesn’t go anywhere near the vineyard. Then Jesus tells his disciples that both will be welcomed into the kingdom of heaven, because even tax collectors are allowed in.

There is always one thing that really gets on my nerves when it comes to travelling on a plane. I always like to get to the airport early, check in and then go and have a coffee and watch as everybody else begins to come in and have to queue up and then see those who arrive late and have to run around the airport. When you get to your destination and wait at the carousel for your luggage, whose luggage comes first? well it certainly isn’t mine, no it’s the luggage of those who arrived late. Then the luggage of those who had to queue for a good length of time comes up at the end. Then just as you think that your bag has got lost, or it fell off the plane, it appears one of the last. So, this means that I now have to queue to get through immigration. It probably means that customs will ask to see inside my suitcase in case I’m bringing a rocket launcher into the country, and finally that the person who is meeting me is at the end of their tethers because they’ve had to wait for so long.
