REFLECTION

Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time Year C

In today’s Gospel Jesus teaches in the Synagogue, we hear that everybody listens intently because his teaching has authority behind it. It is so profound that an unclean spirit yells out his name. The unclean spirit knows that it cannot battle against pure goodness.

Many years when I was in a Parish in Sussex we invited a guest preacher to come and preach at all Masses. He preached very well and everybody was impressed. The theme of his homily was “goodness”. As people left the Church they said to the Parish Priest and myself that it was like a breath of fresh air! Whilst I was happy that everyone was impressed, I was worried that my preaching wasn’t as good as it should be. It made me make a conscious effort to “up my game” and prepare my homilies more diligently.

In life we will meet people who impress us for one reason or another. How often do we think that someone is holier than us? What we may never realise is that others are impressed by us and think that we are holier than them. Of course, what really matters is that when we speak of God and of Jesus it comes from our heart, this is the kind of teaching that will have authority. In order to do this, we must listen and let the word of God truly enter our hearts and lives.
