## REFLECTION

### Ascension Sunday Year A

In today’s Gospel, we hear the account of Jesus just before he is ascending to the Father. In my first Parish of Holy Trinity, Brook Green in Hammersmith, we had a beautiful stained glass window depicting this event.

The window showed a set of feet disappearing into a cloud with the Apostles looking up to the sky. Unfortunately, the window was in a state of disrepair and we had to get some workmen into to fix it. The very day they came I was showing a class of children around the Church. When we came to the window they were all fascinated by the feet. I was asked, “Will he ever return?” I replied, “Yes, at the end of time.” There was then a scream and they all said together, “He’s coming!” Of course, he wasn’t, it was just a workman beginning to take the window out.

We are still waiting for Jesus to return and we are consoled to know that he is still with us. When he ascends, the Apostles may feel a sense of loss. Yet they will soon be filled with the Holy Spirit at the feast of Pentecost.

Let us not forget that one day we shall see God and whilst on earth, as we go about our daily lives, let us never forget that we too journey with the Lord.
