**REFLECTION**

**THIRTIETH SUNDAY YEAR B**

In this day and age our news is full of the need to be free and safe from captors and darkness. Now I’m sure, like some of you, whenever I think of liberation the first thing that comes into my mind is an army with tanks and guns going into another country and forcing regime to surrender. We have a very recent examples of this with the wars in the Middle East.

We look at Jesus Christ as our Saviour and Liberator. In the Gospel we hear of Jesus giving sight to a blind man. In Mark’s Gospel this is the last miracle that Jesus performs before he goes into Jerusalem. The word liberation means to set free to unchain to give freedom. Jesus did this throughout this ministry. Not only in the miracles he performed but also in his preaching. In Luke’s Gospel right at the beginning of Jesus’ ministry when he enters the synagogue he says that he has come to proclaim liberty to captives. When Jesus talks of liberty, he refers to liberty each one of use can feel inside. The liberty of knowing that we have God with us as we journey through life. The liberty we receive by being a follower of Christ. The liberty of knowing that God hears us when we call for help. The liberty of knowing that we are never alone.

Of course the big liberty we gain is when Christ was crucified, he won salvation and liberty for us. The liberty of knowing that this life is not all there is, that there is a life to come called Heaven. When Jesus opened his arms on the cross he embraces the whole of humanity and sets us free. After dying on the cross he descended to the dead and offered liberation to each one of them. He broke through the gates of hell to offer Salvation to all.

The curing of the blind man shows us that he wants each one of us to see his glory and see the Salvations he won for us.

So liberation isn’t about guns and fighting. Liberation is about showing love and respect for one another. Jesus didn’t liberate us by using force. He liberated us by showing his love for us, by dying on the cross.
