**REFLECTION**

Twenty Sixth Sunday Year B

In the Gospel today Jesus warns us against becoming an ‘exclusive’ religion. A little club that is very hard to join. The idea that we are Catholic and everyone else is inferior to us. Jesus warns John that just because someone isn’t an Apostle, doesn’t mean that they are automatically against Jesus. He warns against judging people before we actually know them.

Our Church should always be a place of welcome –we have welcomers in our porch to encourage this feeling. I remember many years ago people from the Diocese of Westminster gathered for the launch of the ‘At Word Lord’ programme. As one of the organisers I was running round all night trying to get people into position. There were two things I noticed, first how wonderful it was to have over 8,000 people from all over the Diocese under one roof all singing and worshipping together. I also noticed how wonderful and prayerful the atmosphere was despite the fact we were in an arena, which is more used for American Wrestling and music concerts. All this supports the idea that it is the people who make the Church, as they have done for over 2,000 years it really doesn’t matter where we are, whether we have buildings or not. What really matters is all of you. You are the Church, the living stones. The second thing that encouraged me was when I was leaving the arena, was that there were many people congratulating me. Then parishioners from my previous Home Parish of Wembley Park came up and greeted me. Then some parishioners from Fulham where I was as a student came over running and shouting at me and then there were lots of hugs which made me realise that if everybody felt that welcome in our Church what a wonderful Church this would be. We can do it when we want to. So let us ask God to help us make everyone feel welcome in our Church that everyone can feel fully a part of our Community.
